#### SuperGold

Card holders with their concession loaded onto their Bee Card will travel free during off peak times (9am to 3pm and from 6.30pm weekdays and all day weekends and public holidays).



#### Children 5-15 years of age

Children aged 5-15 years of age with their date of birth loaded onto their registered Bee Card will access half price fares on Te Huia. Please note children under the age of 5 travel free and do not require a Bee Card.



#### **Community Services**

Card holders with their concession loaded on to their Bee Card receive half price travel on any public transport service.




#### **Accessibility Concession**



- ★ The Strand is a 20 min walk to the waterfront (along Beach Rd).
- Buses leave from SH16 (400m/5 min walk) towards the city centre.
- Buses leave from Quay St (800m/10 min walk) towards the city centre.

## On board

#### How to pay

Te Huia is a public transport service, so you don't book a seat\* or pay in advance - everything is done on the train, on the day.

If you're using a Bee Card, the train manager will come through the carriage to take your fare. You can pay for two or more people on a single Bee Card.

If you're paying the cash fare, you'll need to do this at the on board cafe.


